

Language Learning Expectations at the End of Lower Key Stage 2

Listen and Respond

- understand statements and questions.
- respond to statements, questions and instructions.
- listen to and understand short passages that use vocabulary that we have been learning.
- fit actions to simple songs and traditional rhymes.

Speak

- answer questions with short phrases.
- describe familiar situations, e.g. in school, at home, in the town.
- participate in a short, structured conversation.
- use phrases to express our feelings.

Read and Respond

- read short phrases.
- match single words and phrases to the appropriate picture in a book.
- use a glossary to find the meaning of unfamiliar words.

Write

- copy words and short phrases.
- write signs that include single words and short phrases.
- write words and phrases from memory to describe situations.
- choose words to finish short sentences and to respond to questions.

Develop cultural understanding

- talk about special festivals and events.
- record our understanding through drawing and simple sentences.
- use sources, such as books or the internet, to research special events.
