Some of the changes to make things safer are: smaller groups and less sessions, staggered drop off/pick up times, different venues and activities, sessions taking place online.

There will be different changes depending on the Short Break session. Please check with the Short Break provider to find out what the arrangements are and when sessions will be running.

Families can attend one activity session per week during term-time and two activity sessions per week during the school holidays.
