<p><b>Colour Run – Practise the Fundamental Skills</b></p> <p>Red = stop Green = run Amber = walk Blue = hop Purple = skip Yellow = jump</p>	<p><b>Number Hunt</b></p> <p>On a walk look for numbers on doors, bins, signs etc. Choose 3 numbers you spot and write them down. Write the number that is 1 more and 1 less next to each.</p> <p>Challenge: What is 10 more and 10 less?</p>
<p><b>Mini-Beast Hunt</b></p> <p>Go outside (take a magnifying glass and bug pot if you have one) to look under logs, stones and leaves. You can tally or draw/label what minibeasts that you find.</p>	<p><b>Harvest Printing</b></p> <p>Use potatoes, carrots or apples as stamps to make colourful harvest prints.</p> <p><b><u>Adults you will need to support your child with this.</u></b></p>
<p><b>Animal Homes in Autumn</b></p> <p>Choose an animal (hedgehog, squirrel, fox, owl etc). Make a little model of its autumn home using leaves, twigs, boxes or Lego. Take a photo or draw your model and label the animal's home.</p>	<p><b>Autumn Art</b></p> <p>Collect some autumn leaves or natural objects. Use them to make a collage or pattern. Take a photo, stick it in, or bring in what you created.</p>
