Teaching and Whole School Strategies: including Mental health, social, emotional, welfare and readiness for learning of pupils. If children are feeling anxious, stressed or suffering from ACEs extra tutoring will be pointless until they are in a calm and safe place and then able to access learning.	 Counselling sessions for pupils who have suffered mental health difficulties, bereavement, ACEs and trauma due to COVID-19 e.g. DA, illness in family. Cost of counsellor time - £3360 Nurture sessions for pupils to reengage in learning.
